

The Compounding Lab Testosterone

WHAT IS IN THIS LEAFLET

This CMI covers the compounded products Testosterone Enanthate and Testosterone Cypionate.

WHAT IS IT USED FOR

Testosterone is a naturally occurring hormone in the body that is crucial in the development of sexual organs and tissue in men. It is also responsible for increasing muscle and bone mass.

This medication is used when the body does not naturally produce enough of the hormone.

WHEN NOT TO USE

Do not use this compounded medication if you are allergic to any of the ingredients in the product including benzyl alcohol and cottonseed oil or sesame oil.

Do not use this medication past the BUD date written on the vial.

Do not use this medication if you have prostate cancer, breast cancer or previous, existing, or malignant tumors.

HOW TO USE

Testosterone Enanthate/Cypionate should be slowly injected into muscle tissue by your doctor.

SIDE EFFECTS

- pain, redness or swelling at the injection site
- cough
- shortness of breath
- hair loss/growth
- acne
- rash
- weight gain
- aggression
- changes in libido

If you experience any of the below side effects tell your doctor immediately or go to your nearest Emergency department

- chest pain
- yellowing of the skin (Jaundice)
- allergic reactions (rash, swelling of the face, lips, mouth throat, wheezing, difficulty breathing)
- severe stomach pain or tenderness
- unwanted, frequent, prolonged and painful erections

Abuse of this medication can lead to serious adverse effects that in some cases can be fatal.
