

GHK-CU 5MG/ML IN VERSAPRO CREAM

Copper Peptide GHK-Cu 0.5%

This leaflet provides important information about using GHK-Cu Face Cream.

You should also speak to your doctor or pharmacist if you would like further information or if you have any concerns or questions about using GHK-Cu Face Cream.

WHY AM I USING GHK-CU CREAM?

GHK-Cu Face Cream contains the active ingredient Copper Peptide GHK-Cu. GHK-Cu Face Cream is a cosmeceutical product designed to improve skin health and appearance. It is used to reduce fine lines and deeply hydrate the skin.

It has been compounded specifically for you as there is no equivalent or suitable TGA-approved medicine commercially available in Australia

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW BEFORE I USE GHK-CU CREAM?

WARNINGS

Do not use GHK-Cu Face Cream if:

- you are allergic to Copper Peptide GHK-Cu, or any of the ingredients listed at the end of this leaflet.
- Always check the ingredients to make sure you can use this medicine.
- you have open wounds or active skin infections in the area to be treated.

CHECK WITH YOUR DOCTOR IF YOU:

- have any other medical conditions,

particularly skin conditions such as eczema or psoriasis.

- take any medicines for any other condition.

- are undergoing other skin treatments.

During treatment, you may be at risk of developing certain side effects. It is important you understand these risks and how to monitor for them.

PREGNANCY AND BREASTFEEDING

Check with your doctor if you are pregnant or intend to become pregnant. Talk to your doctor if you are breastfeeding or intend to breastfeed.

WHAT IF I AM TAKING OTHER MEDICINES?

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking any other medicines, including any medicines, vitamins or supplements that you buy without a prescription from your pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

MEDICINES THAT MAY INCREASE THE EFFECT OF [MEDICINE NAME] INCLUDE:

Other skin care products containing active ingredients such as retinoids or alpha-hydroxy acids.

HOW DO I USE GHK-CU CREAM?

HOW MUCH TO TAKE /USE

- Apply a small amount to the affected area as directed by your doctor or pharmacist.



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- Follow the instructions provided and use GHK-Cu Face Cream until your doctor tells you to stop.

WHEN TO USE GHK-CU CREAM

- GHK-Cu Face Cream should be used once daily or as directed by your healthcare professional.

HOW TO APPLY GHK-CU CREAM

1. Cleanse your face thoroughly.
2. Apply a small amount of GHK-Cu Face Cream to your fingertips.
3. Gently massage into the skin until fully absorbed.
4. Wash your hands after application.

WHAT SHOULD I KNOW WHILE USING GHK-CU CREAM?

THINGS YOU SHOULD DO

- Call your doctor straight away if you:
 - experience any severe skin reactions.
 - notice any worsening of your condition.
- Remind any doctor, dentist, or pharmacist you visit that you are using GHK-Cu Face Cream.

THINGS YOU SHOULD NOT DO

- Avoid excessive sun exposure and use sunscreen when outdoors.

LOOKING AFTER YOUR MEDICINE

Store it in a cool dry place away from moisture, heat or sunlight; for example, do not store it:

- in the bathroom or near a sink, or
- in the car or on window sills.

Keep it where young children cannot reach it.

WHEN TO DISCARD YOUR MEDICINE

Do not use this medicine after the expiry date.

GETTING RID OF ANY UNWANTED MEDICINE

If you no longer need to use this medicine or it is out of date, take it to any pharmacy for safe disposal.

Do not use this medicine after the expiry date.

ARE THERE ANY SIDE EFFECTS?

All medicines can have side effects. If you do experience any side effects, most of them are minor and temporary. However, some side effects may need medical attention.

See the information below and, if you need to, ask your doctor or pharmacist if you have any further questions about side effects.

LESS SERIOUS SIDE EFFECTS

LESS SERIOUS SIDE EFFECTS	WHAT TO DO
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mild skin irritation• Redness or itching• Dryness or flaking	Speak to your doctor if you have any of these less serious side effects and they worry you.

SERIOUS SIDE EFFECTS

SERIOUS SIDE EFFECTS	WHAT TO DO
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Severe skin reactions• Allergic reactions such as rash, itching, swelling, or difficulty breathing	Call your doctor straight away, or go straight to the Emergency Department at your nearest hospital if you notice any of these serious side effects.



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Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you notice anything else that may be making you feel unwell.

Other side effects not listed here may occur in some people.

REPORTING SIDE EFFECTS

After you have received medical advice for any side effects you experience, you can report side effects to the Therapeutic Goods Administration online at www.tga.gov.au/reporting-problems. By reporting side effects, you can help provide more information on the safety of this medicine.

Always make sure you speak to your doctor or pharmacist before you decide to stop taking any of your medicines.

Other ingredients (inactive ingredients)	Aloe Barbadensis Leaf Juice, Cyclopentasiloxane, Disodium EDTA, Emulsifying Wax NF, Ethylhexylglycerin, Ethylhexyl Stearate, Glycerin, Phenoxyethanol, Sorbitol, Tocopheryl Acetate, Water
Potential allergens	Corn and products thereof, phenoxyethanol

Do not take this medicine if you are allergic to any of these ingredients.
